The shared map workflow

01

Administrator

Marks entrances, destinations and places to avoid.

02

Review + publish

Checks the changes and publishes the current map.

03

Guest

Opens the shared link or QR.
No account needed.

Approved workers can send private feedback for the administrator to review.

Equipment access



MILL CREEK

The approach is green.

The wrong road is orange.
A red X closes the creek crossing.

Restrictions stay visible
in English, Spanish
and French.

Construction staging



CEDAR WORKS

One delivery gate.

Check-in, unloading and storage have clear marks.

Temporary crews can see where each job begins.

Wedding arrivals



RIVERSIDE HOUSE

QR on the invitation.

Guests see the entrance,
parking and ceremony site.

A service lane stays clearly
out of the guest approach.

Marina arrivals



HARBOR POINT

Meet at slip B12.

The map connects guest parking to the right dock.

Staff access stays separate from the guest approach.

Field orientation

The entrance.

The destination.

The place to avoid.

Exact ROW boundaries and survey targets stay
in the approved project tools.

Early access pilot. Check current site instructions before entering.
No turn-by-turn navigation or surveying.

Pan around. Check the legend.
Preview a change to the map.
